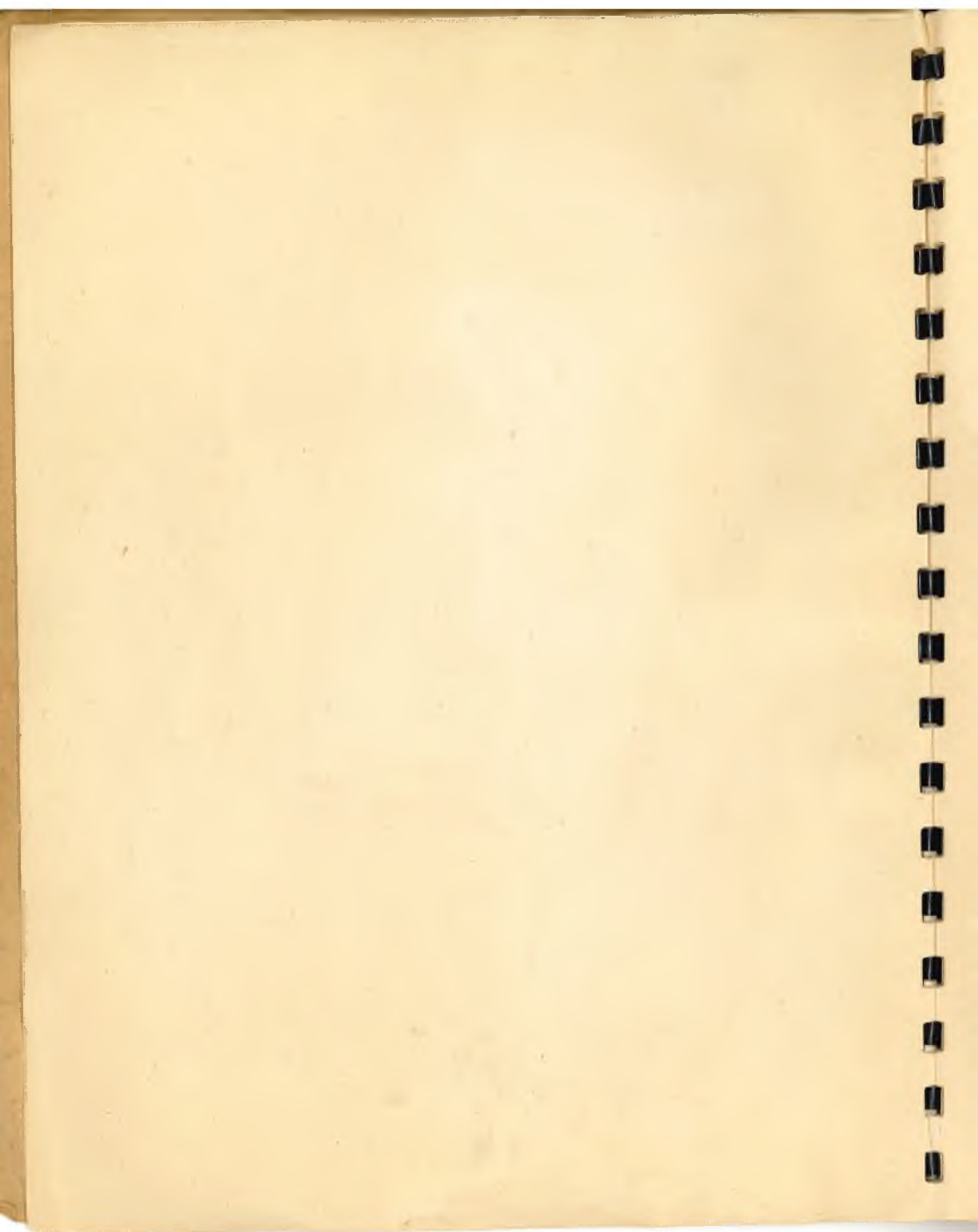

## *Dedication*

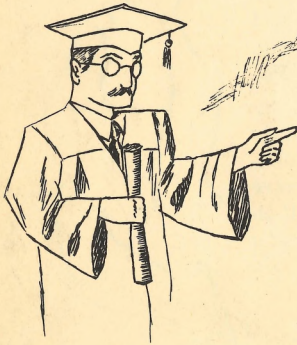
