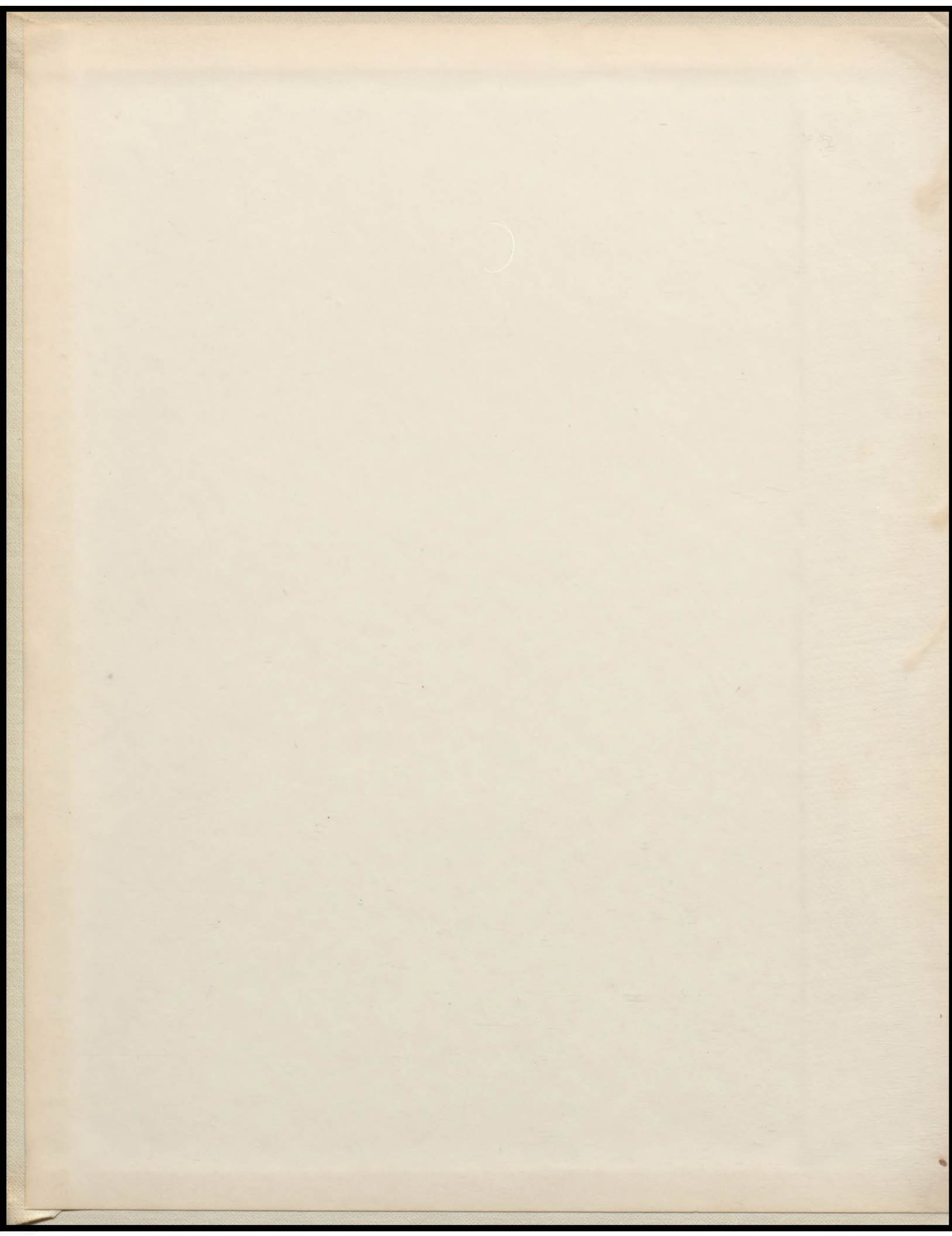

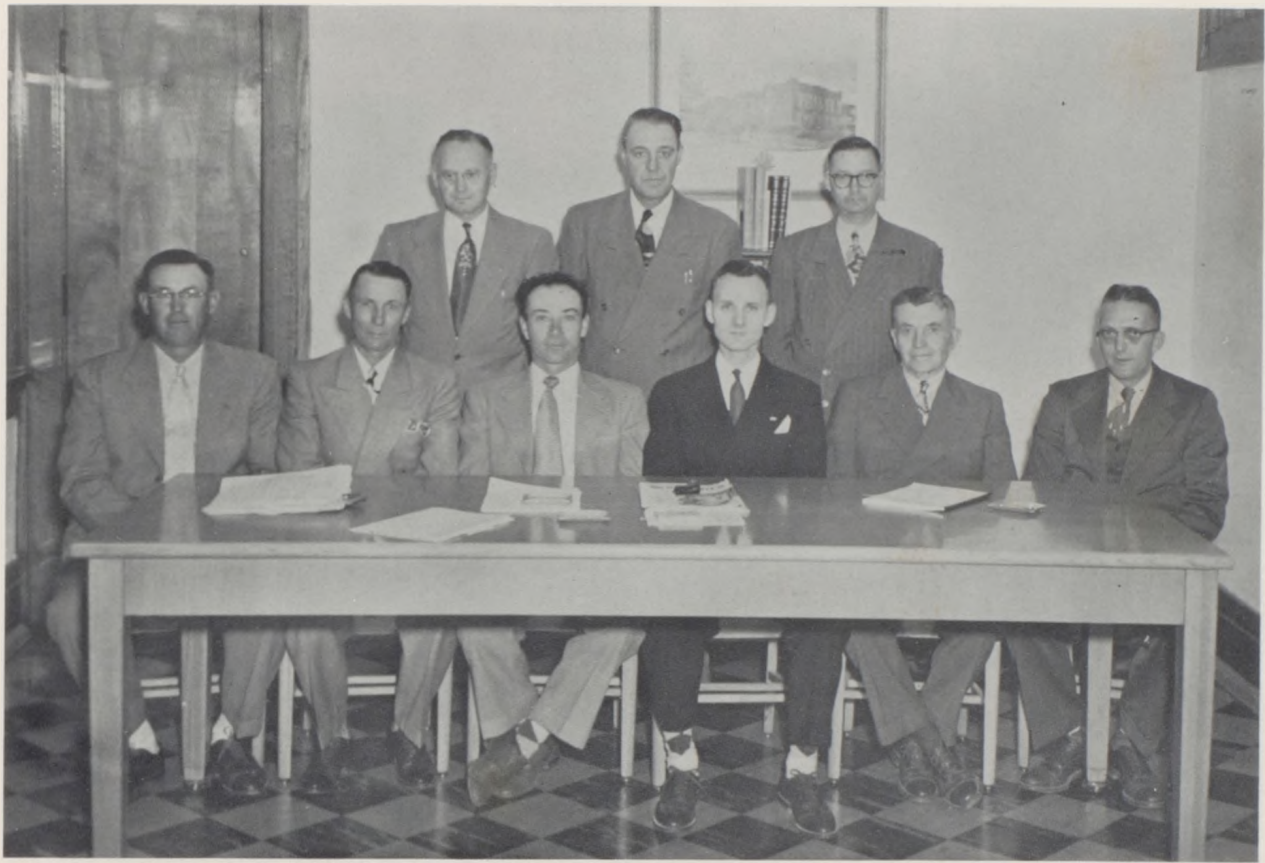

The Cameron Student Council President and three delegates attended the Missouri Association of Student Councils at Ferguson, Missouri.

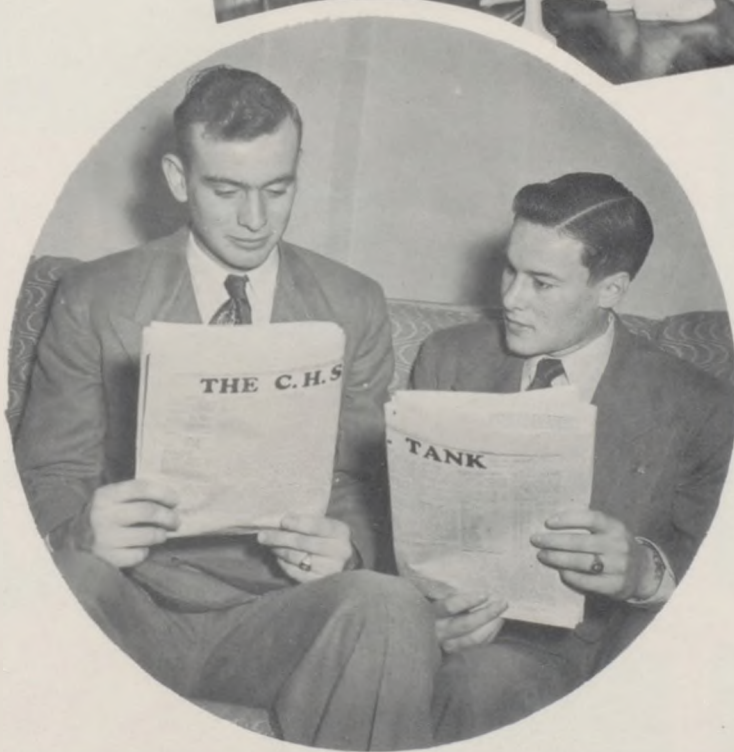
