For her name was "Beverly Ann".



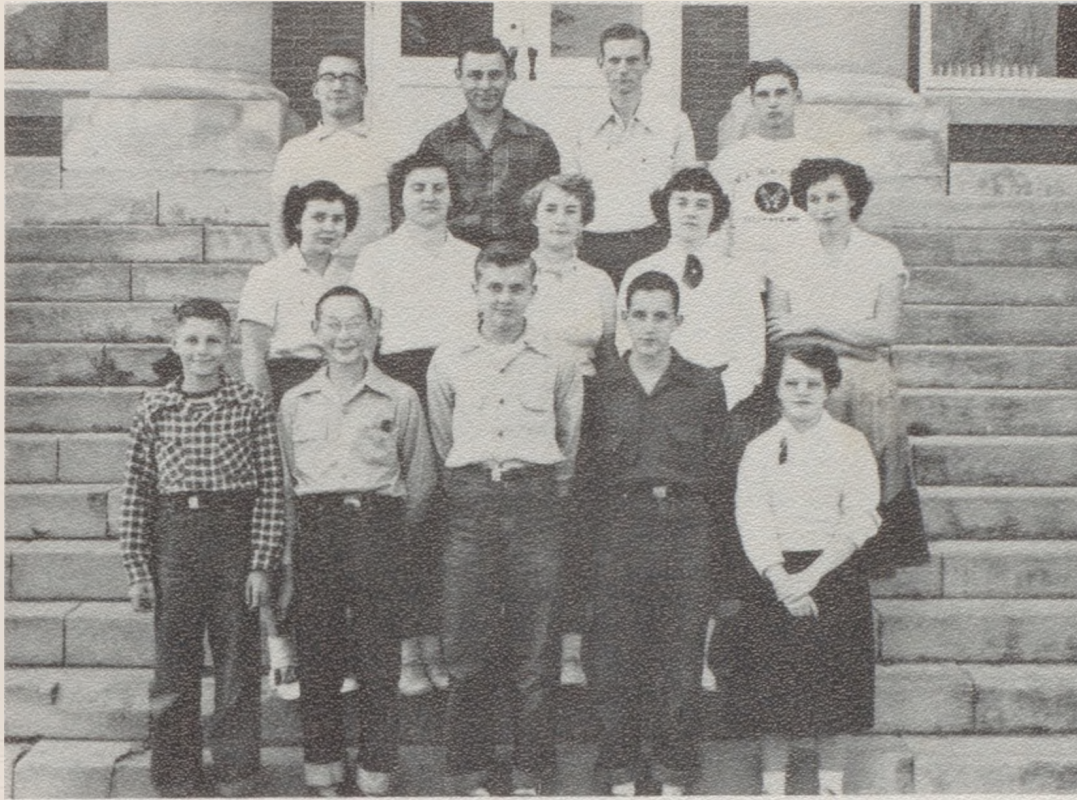
