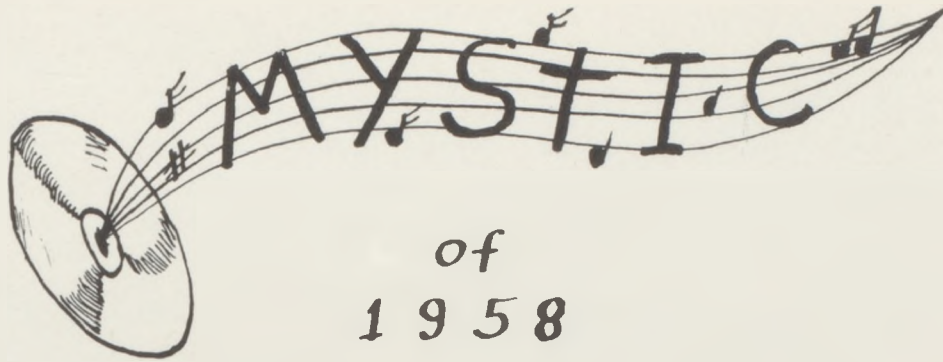

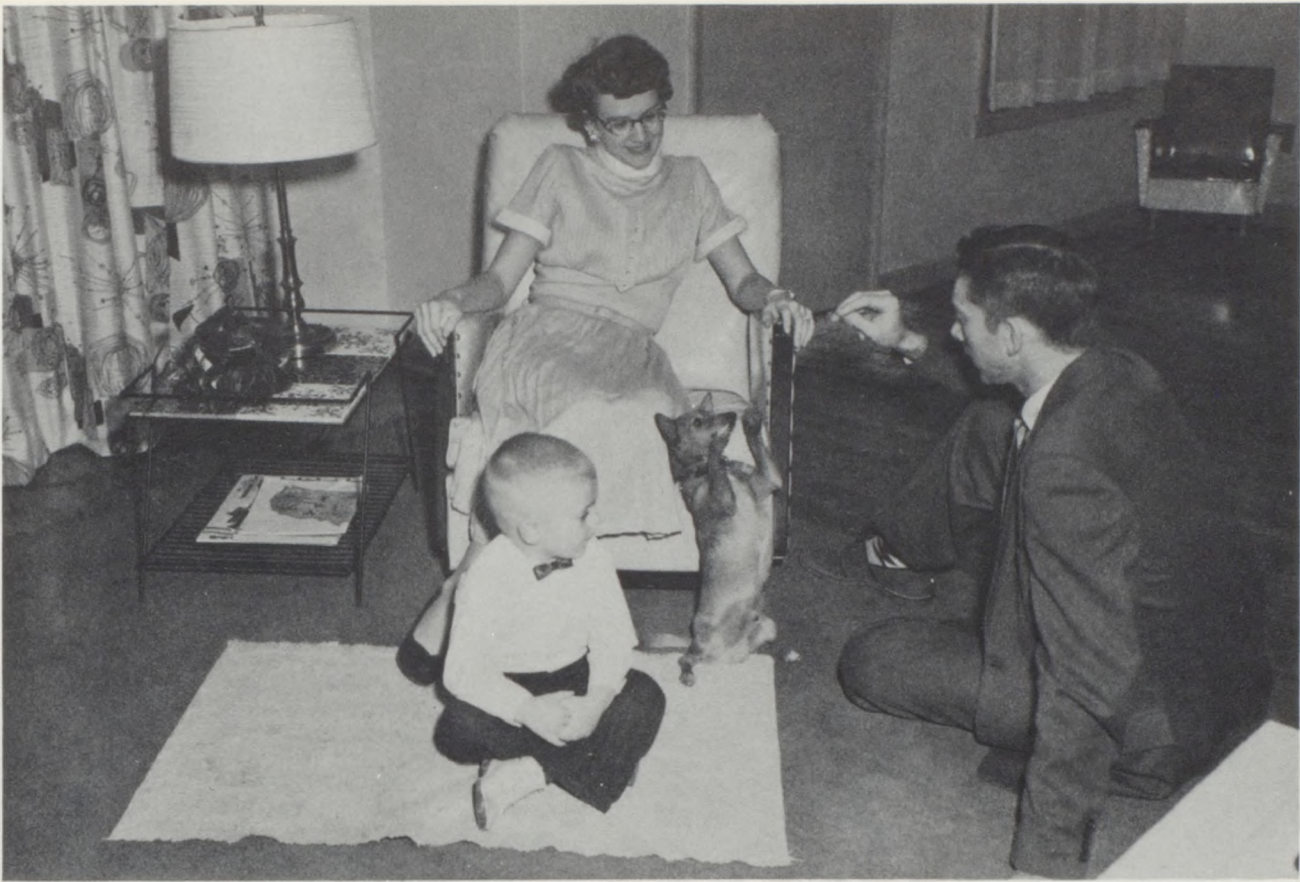

I have gained valuable experience in my association with the faculty and student body, and I hope that as years go by, students will reap the rewards of their labors in high school.

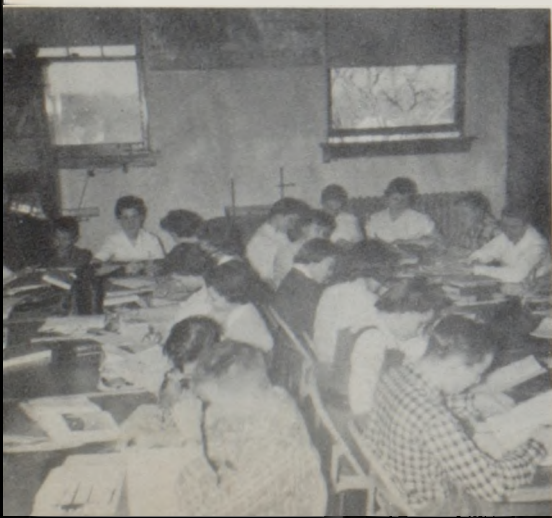
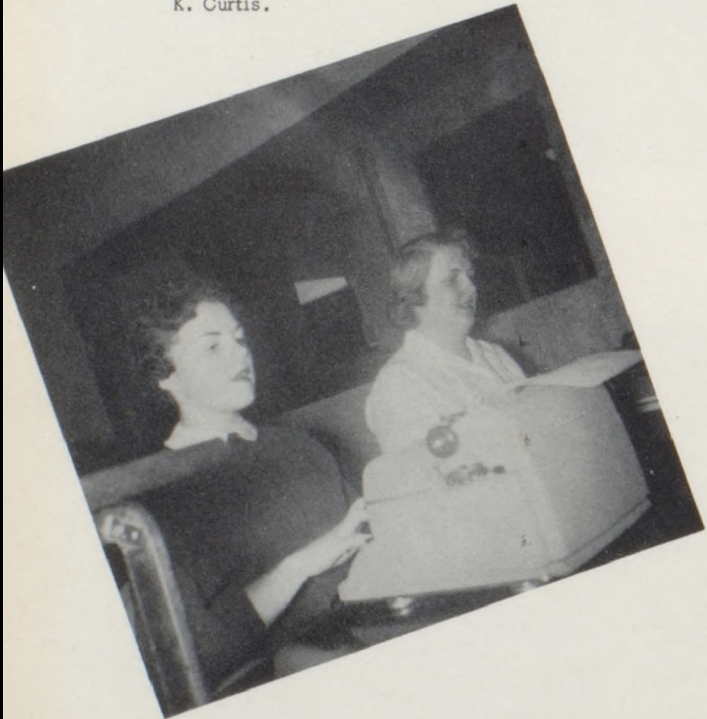


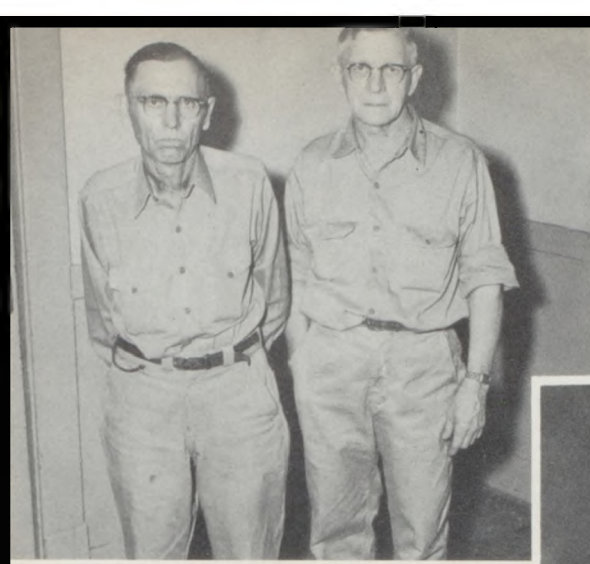
