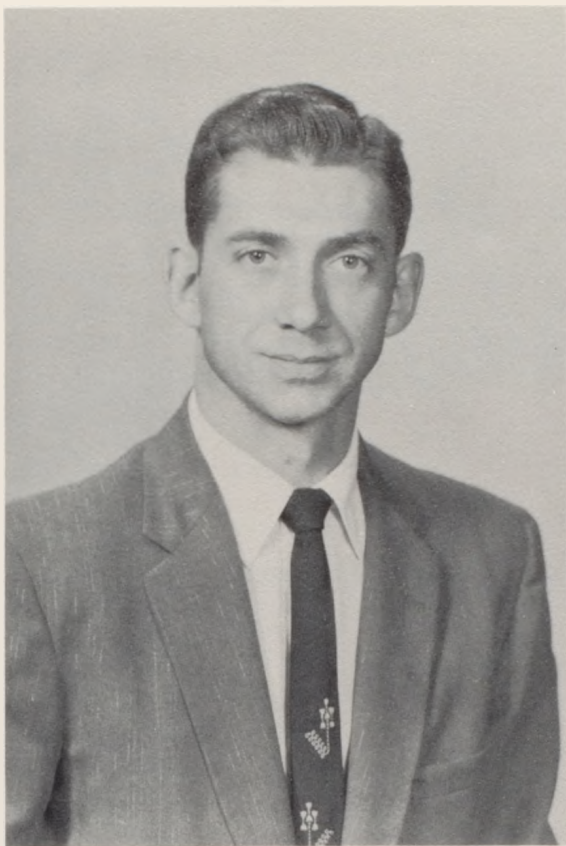
A high school education is most essential in the preparation for future living in a modern world.
