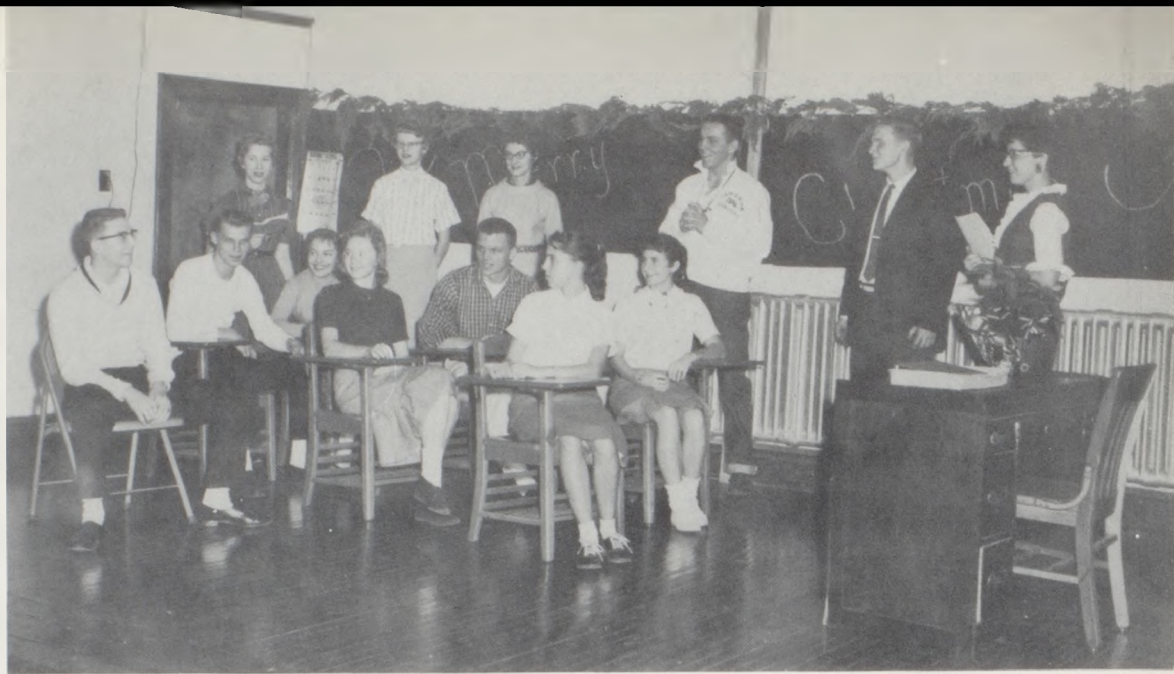
Junior Play "Lute Song"
