Danny's comment is: "I am very happy to have been elected 1962 Tank King. I will always regard it as one of the highlights of my high school days."

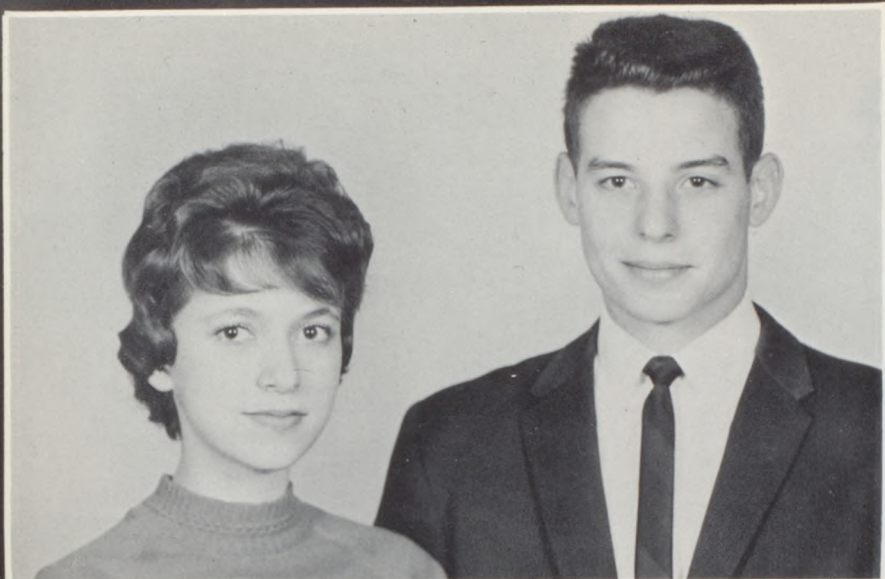
