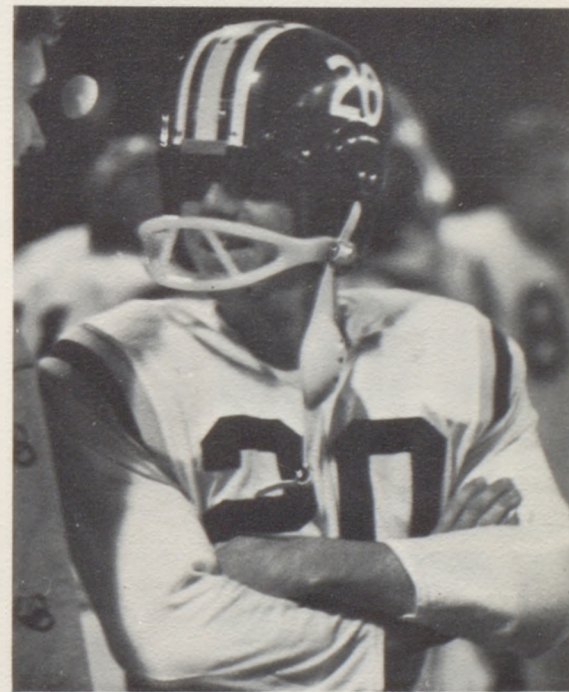
Have Successful Season
