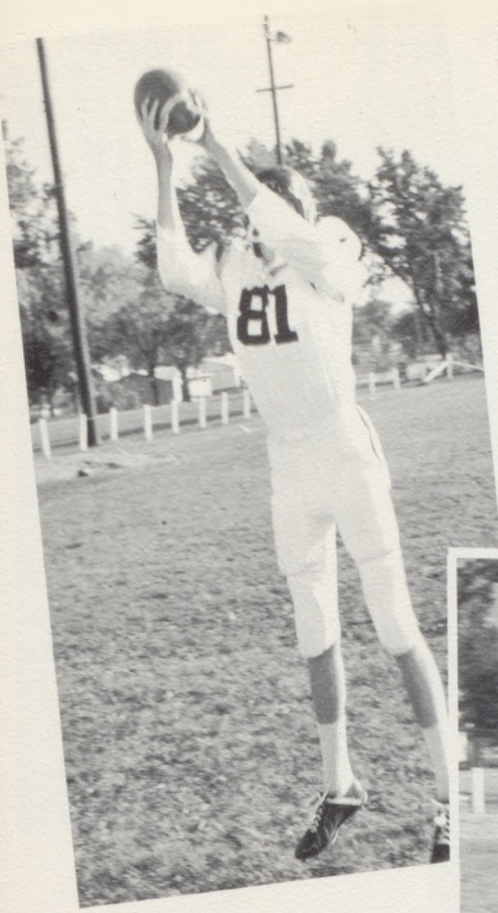
Steps Toward Victory
