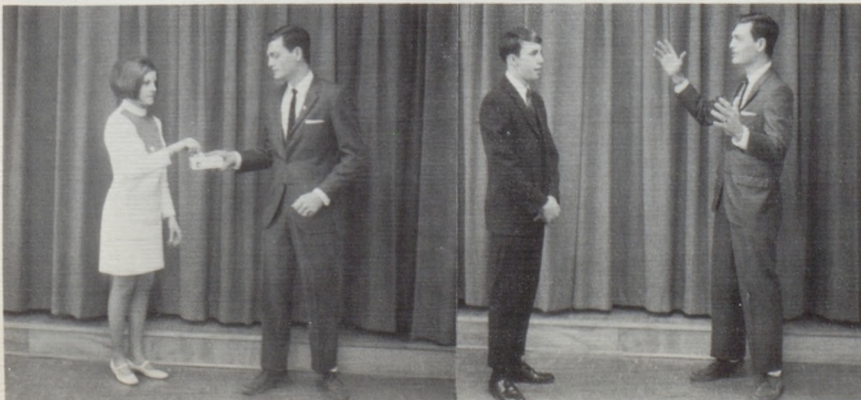


Thespians entered three contests during the 68-69 school year.

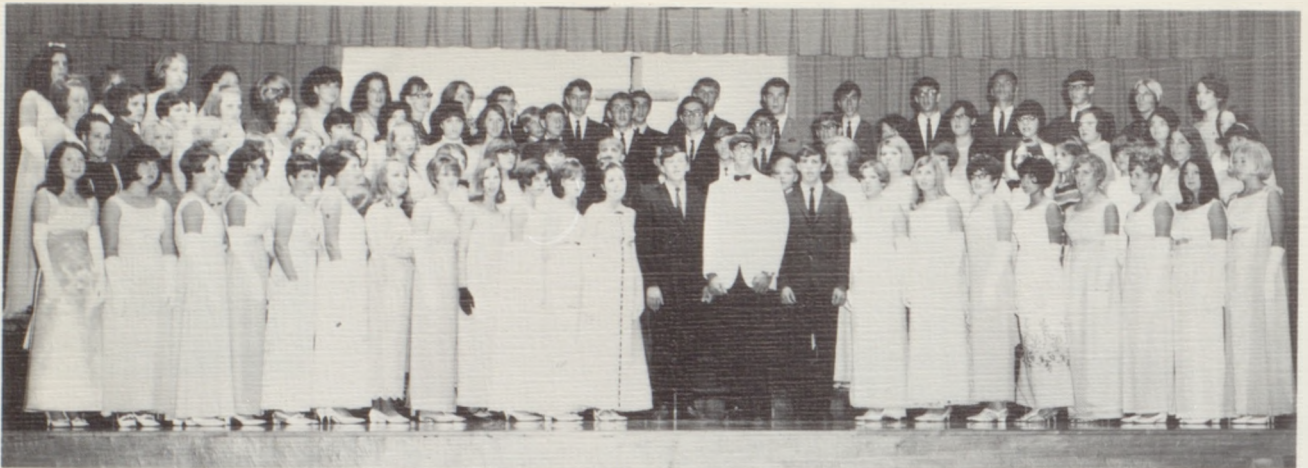
The first contest was the American Legion Oratorical Contest, held in December.

Jay Graham was chosen All-District Guard and Phil Seifert received Honorable Mention for Quarter Back.

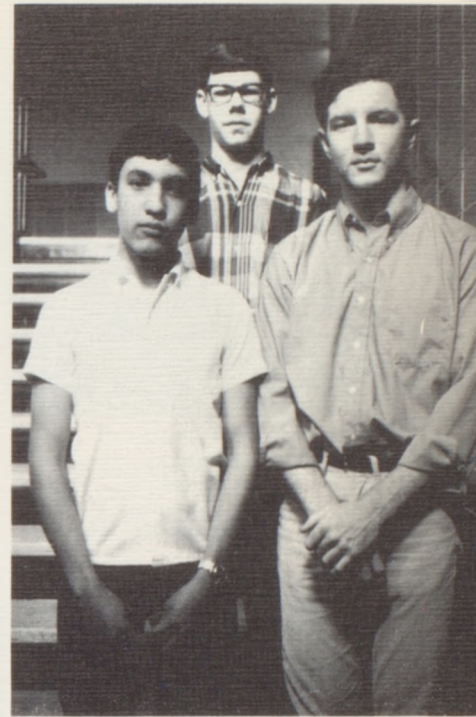

Tuan arrived in Cameron August 12. He is living with his American family, Mr. and Mrs. Jim Quigley and son, Doug.

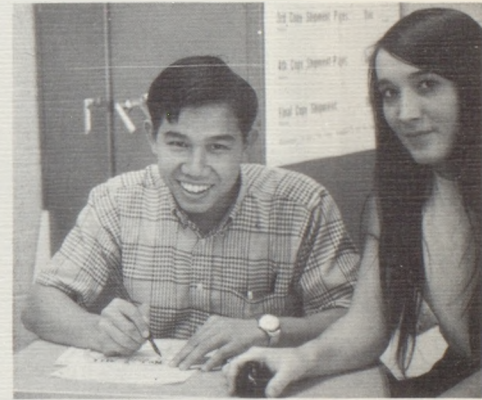
Tuan's family consists of his mother and a sixteen year old brother, Ismaiel. The family occupation is rice farming.
