1971-72 football season

The Cameron Dragons ended the season with an official record of 9-1. Their only loss was a forfeit to Gallatin for allowing an ineligible player to participate. The Dragons shared the Grand River Conference Championship with Bethany. Each had an 8-1 conference record.

The Dragons scored a total of 428 points, which is the most points scored in one season since 1919. The Dragons had a total of 2793 yards rushing and their opponents had 430 yards. Cameron passed for 746 yards while their opponents passed for 448 yards. The Dragons' total offense was 3539 yards and their opponents was 878 yards. The Dragons' score by quarters was 120-88-109-111. The opponents' score by quarters was 6-12-6-0.

There were six Dragons named to the All-Conference Football Team. Selected for offense were Randy Daniel at halfback, Larry McMullen at tackle, and Rick Thompson on at fullback. Those selected for defense were Dave Christman at halfback, John Wilcox at linebacker, Eric Seifert at end, and Rick Thompson at guard.

Four of the Dragons were named to the All-District Football Team. They were John Wilcox, defensive linebacker; Randy Daniel, offensive halfback; Eric Seifert, defensive end; and Rick Thompson, offensive fullback.

Rick Thompson recieved All-State honorable mention.

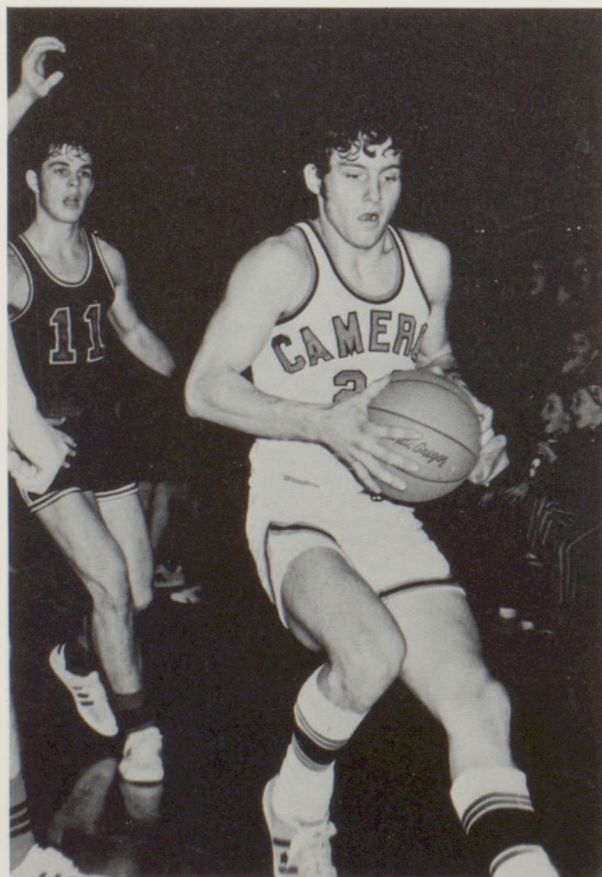


Co-captains Larry McMullen and Lonnie Heldenbrand admire the 1st place trophy won at the G.R.C. Tourney.

Revisions were also made in our school Dress Code.

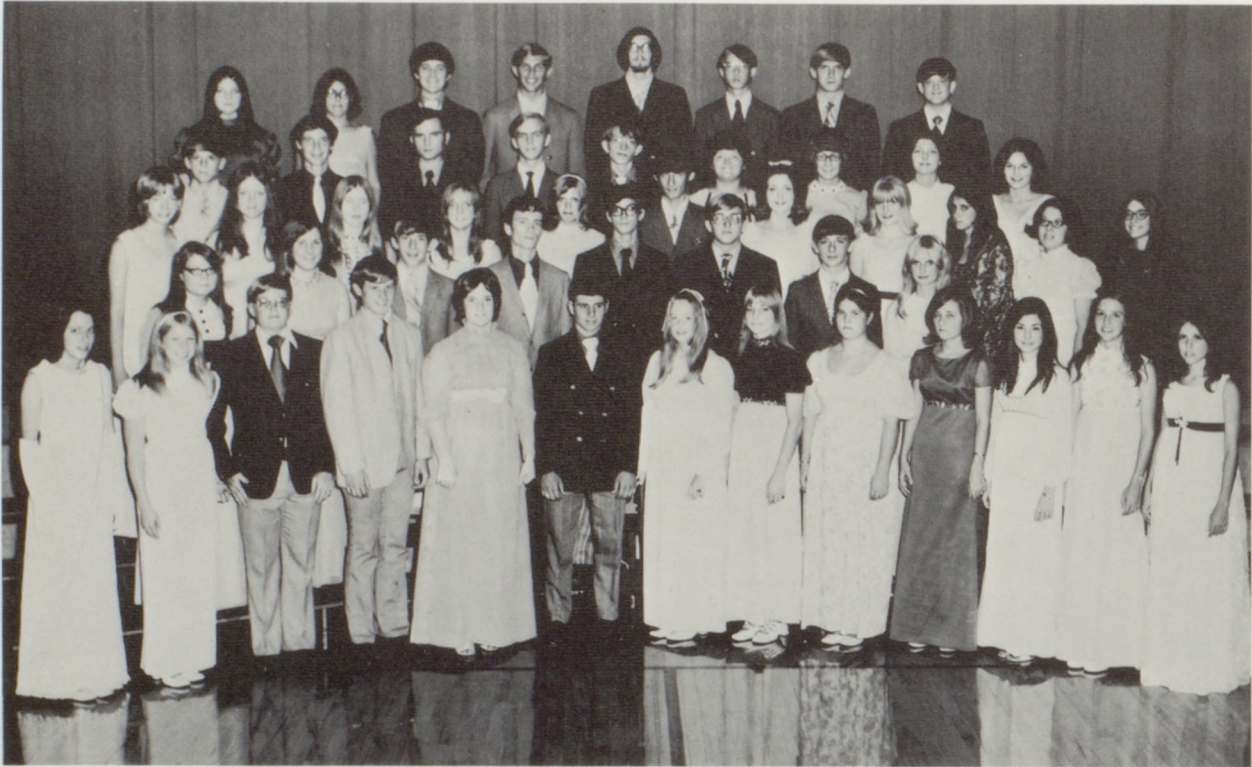
March 16-19 the newly elected Student Council Officers for the 1972-73 school year attended the Annual MASC Convention in Jefferson City.
