The parade followed with 21 entries from various organizations of CHS. Keeping with the 1972 Homecoming theme, "Song Titles", the Seniors

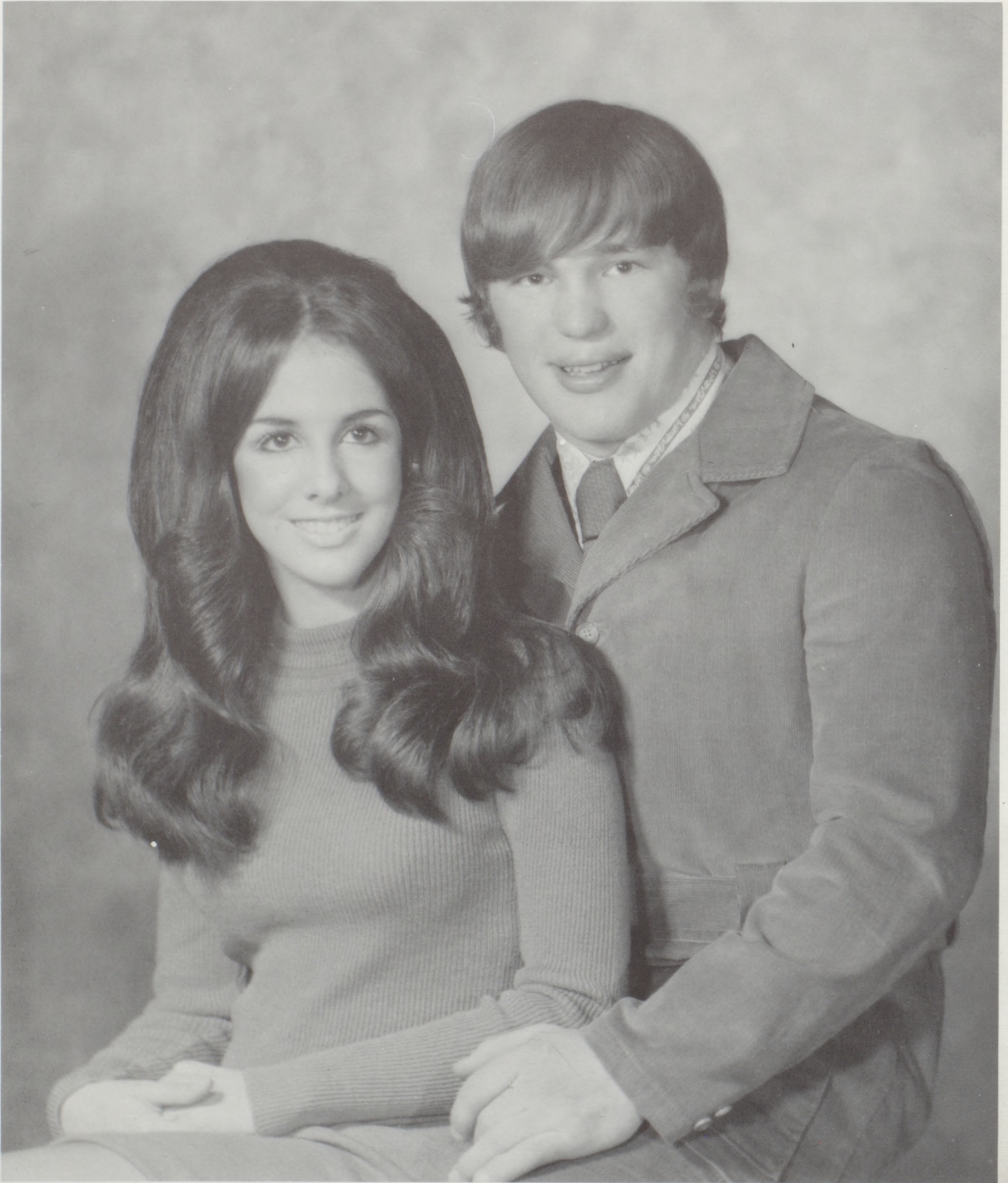

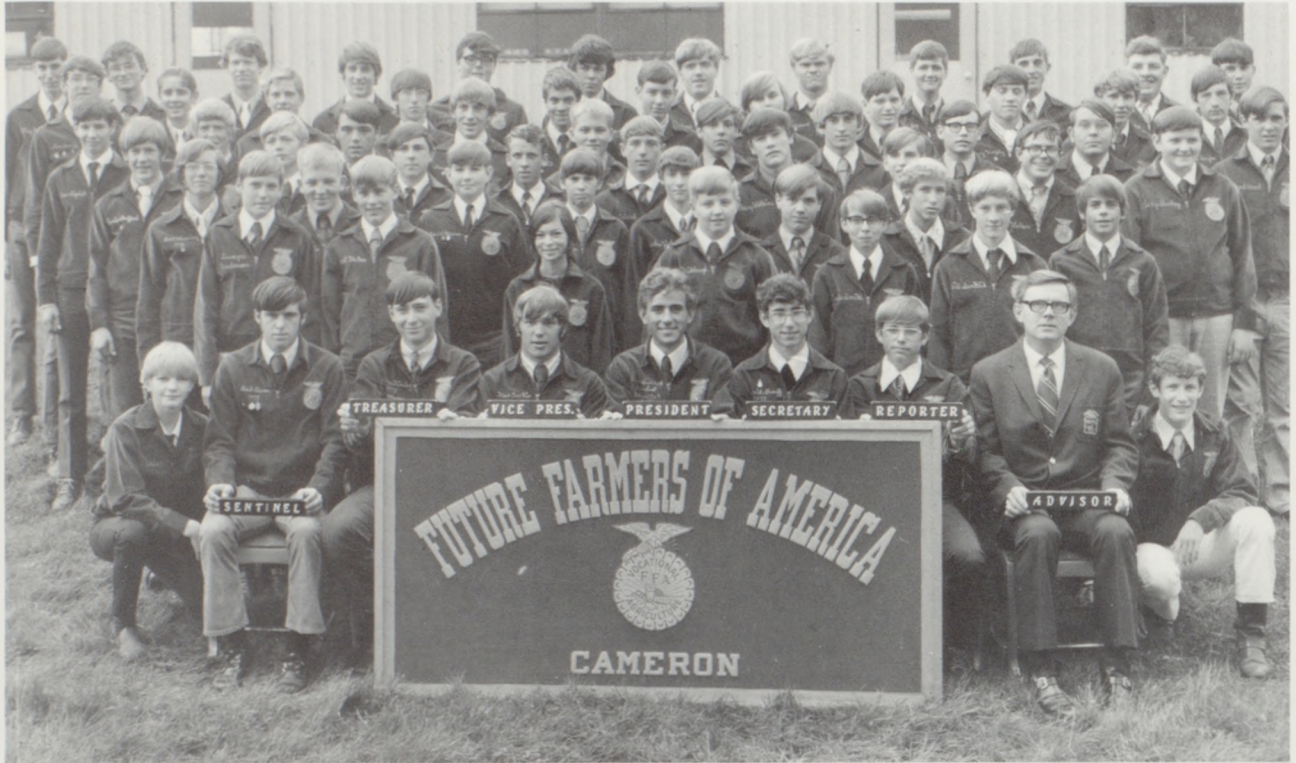

The Children's Barnyard was their project at the annual Fourth of July Celebration.

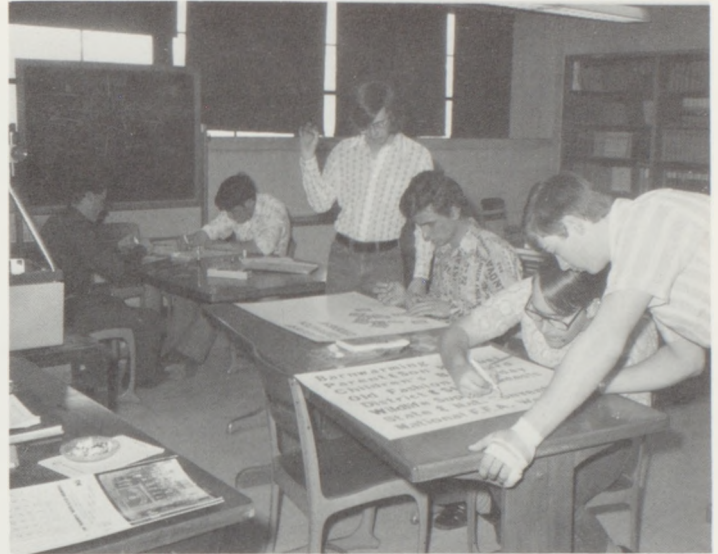
