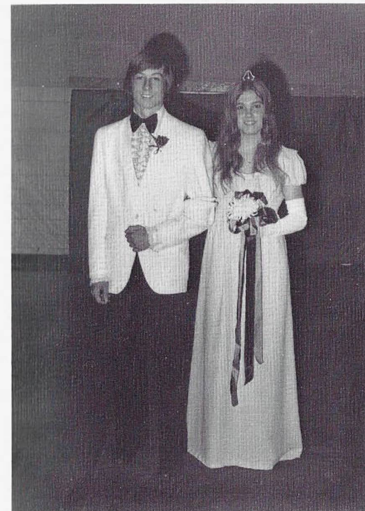
The dragons romped the bulldogs 40-0 and the week ended with the Homecoming Dance at Goodrich Auditorium.

The Thespians presented "Mumbo-Jumbo", a mystery farce, as the annual T-Vues production, November 20. It was directed by Mr. Rob Crouse.

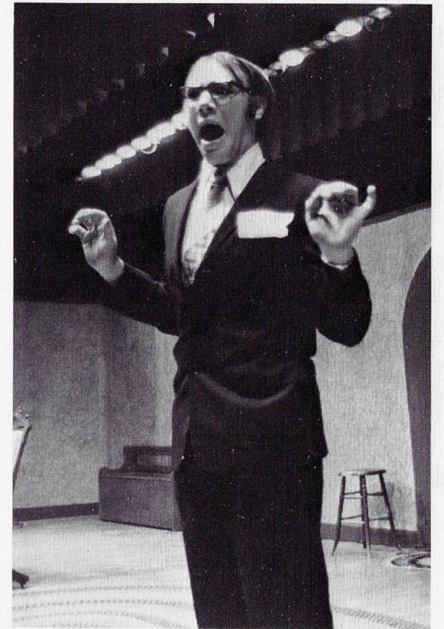
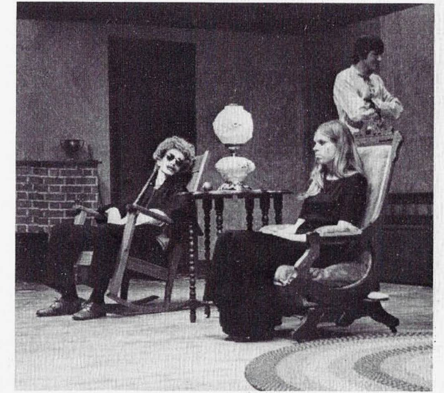

The Student Council is an active organization comprised of representatives elected from each organization and class.

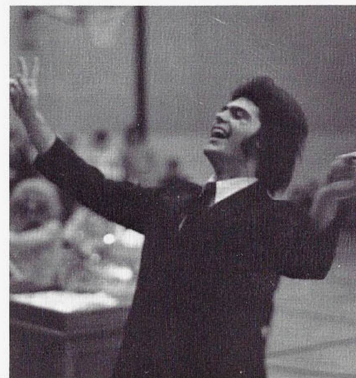
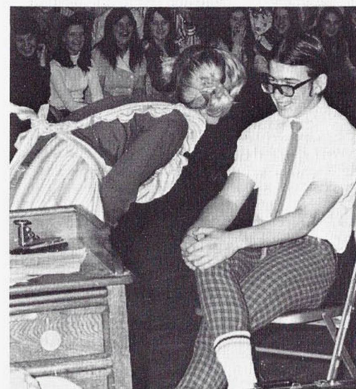
It works to promote those things which will tend to maintain, improve, and advance the scholarship and the physical and moral welfare of the students of Cameron High School.

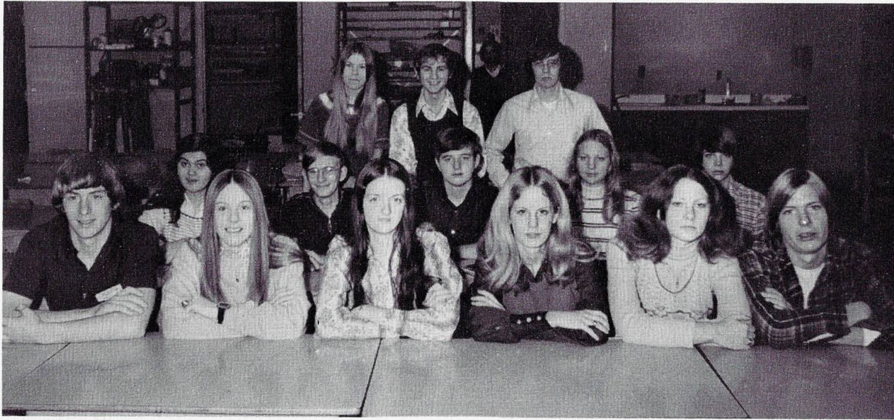
DECA is an organization that enables students to learn by doing. It is the largest nationwide individual youth movement in the U.S.

Radio Day is one of the many activities of DECA. Students participating in Radio Day ran the KMRN radio station for a week, selling and writing ads for various merchants.

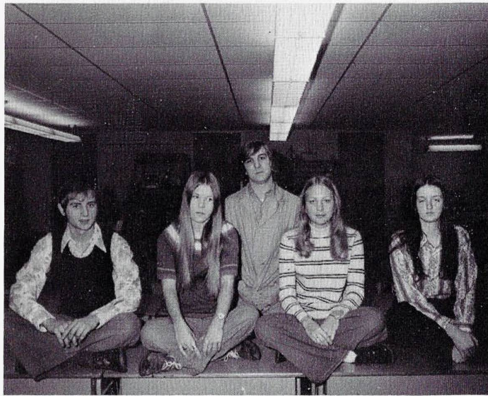
