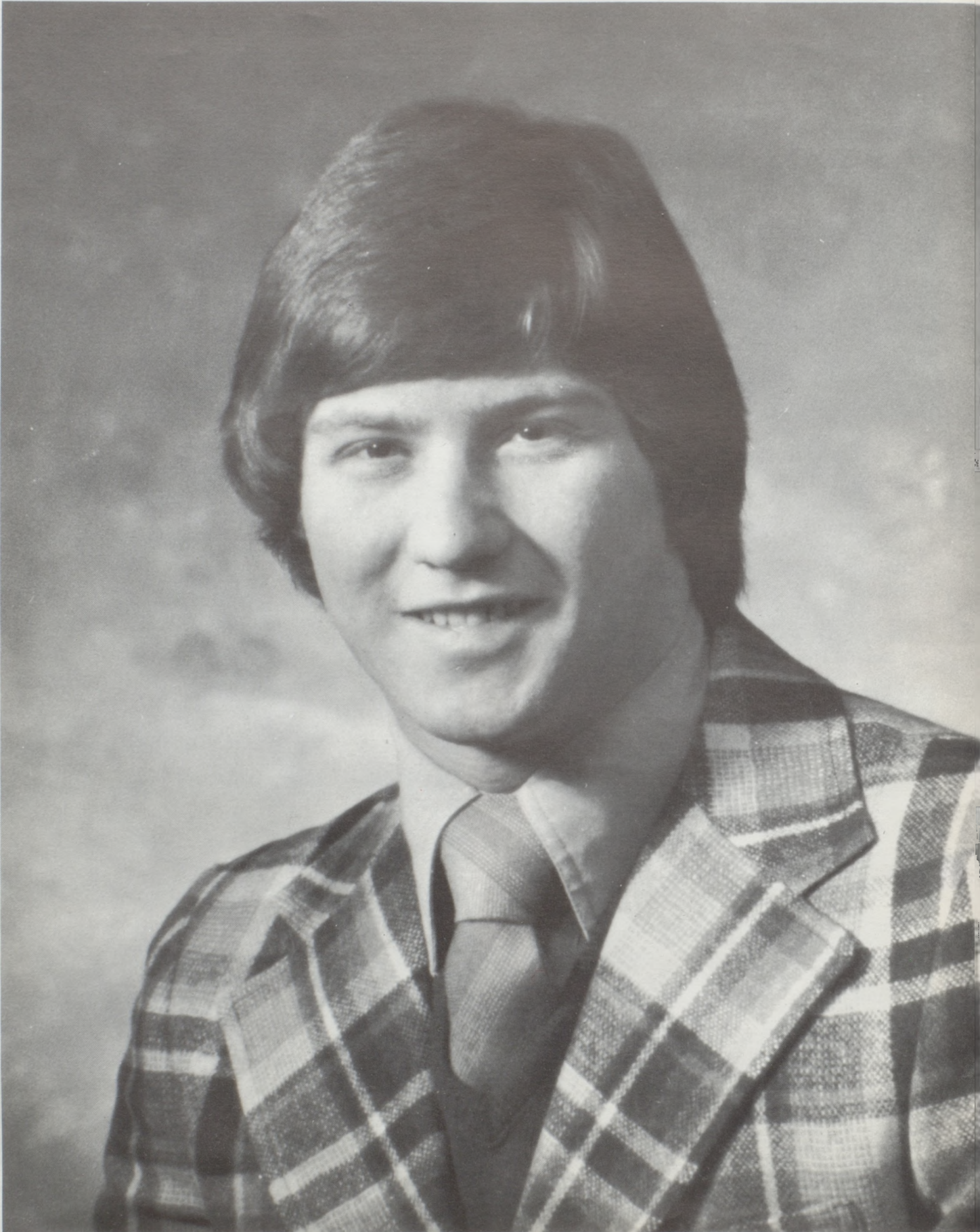
Tom Place was guest speaker at the annual Cornation Ceremony.

Linc Sorensen was chosen for the All-District team for offense and defense.

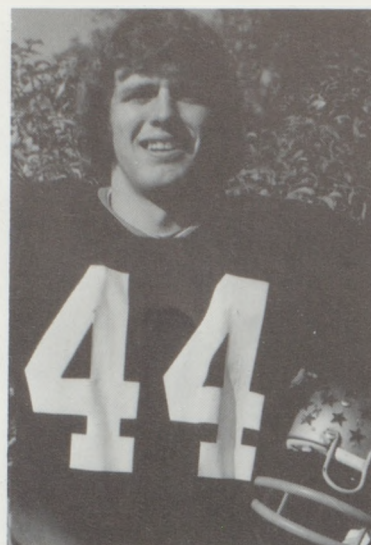
