





rewarding to him in the years to come.

















CHS'ers and alumni boogied to the music of "Plain View," making Homecoming 1976 a day to remember.



Balloons were sold during the week for 50¢ each. The name and address of the buyer was placed inside with the instructions for the receiver to mail the balloon back to CHS


