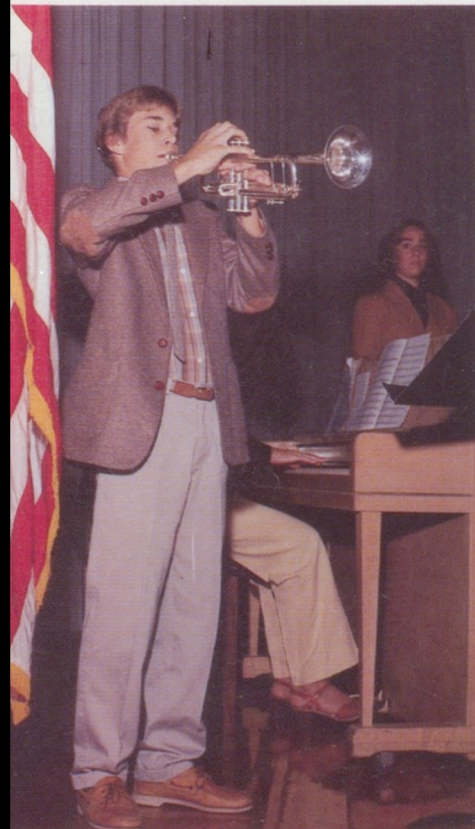

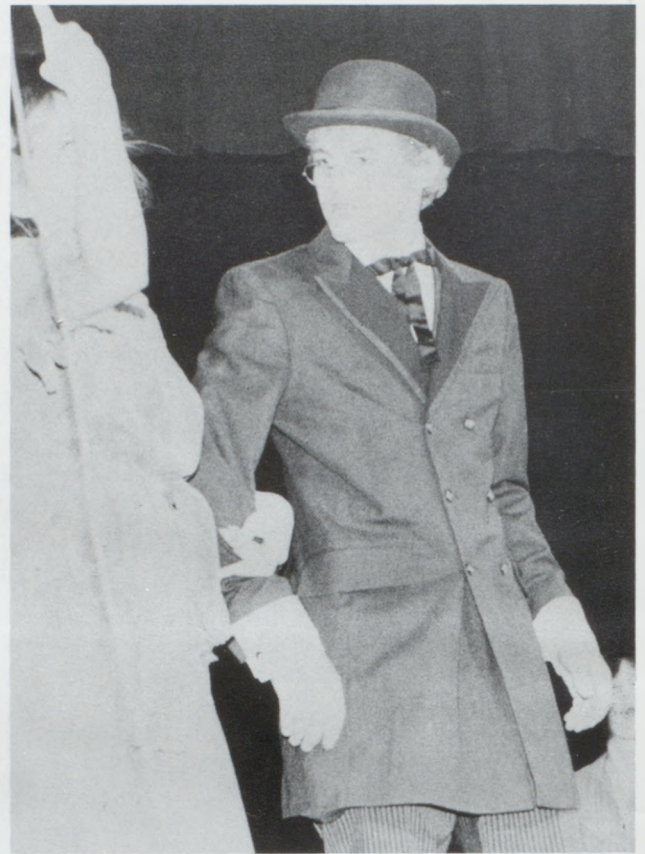

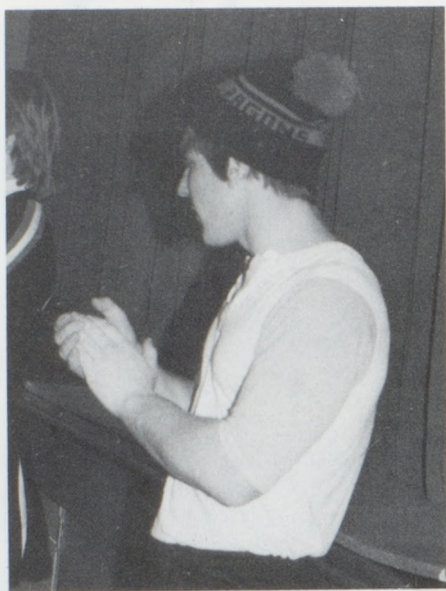

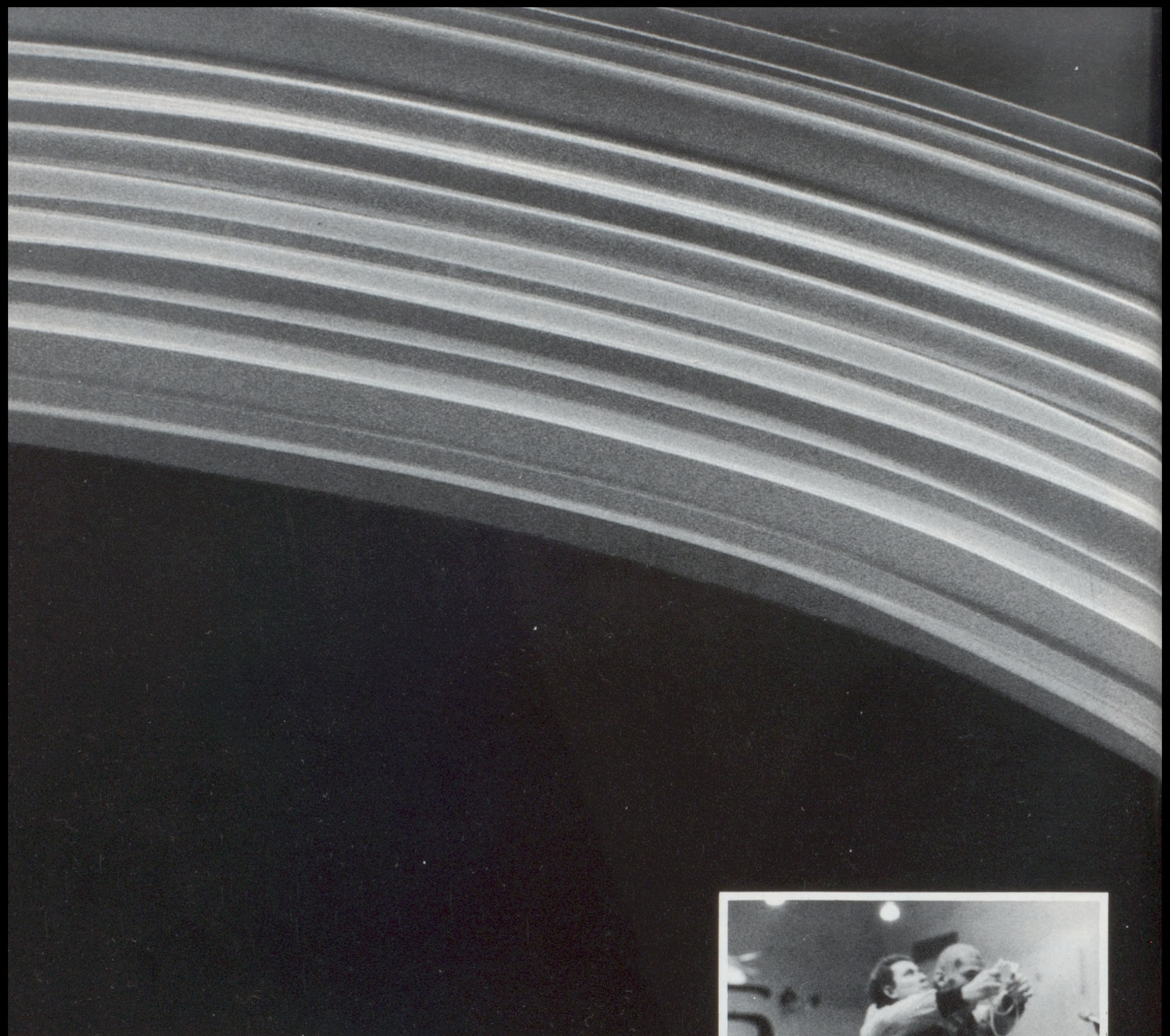

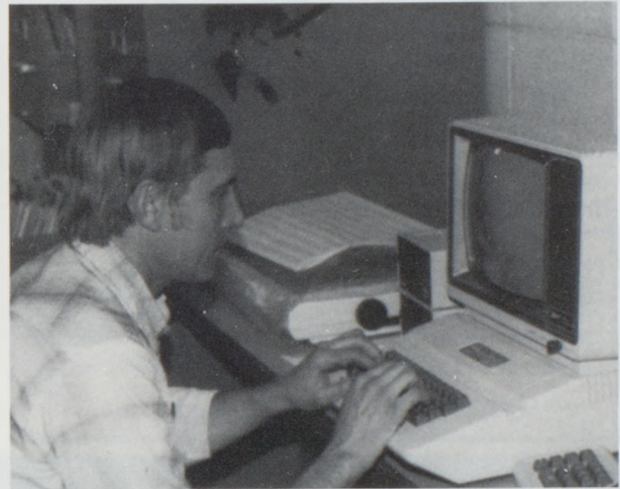

Officers for the coming year were initiated at the annual tea held at the end of the year.

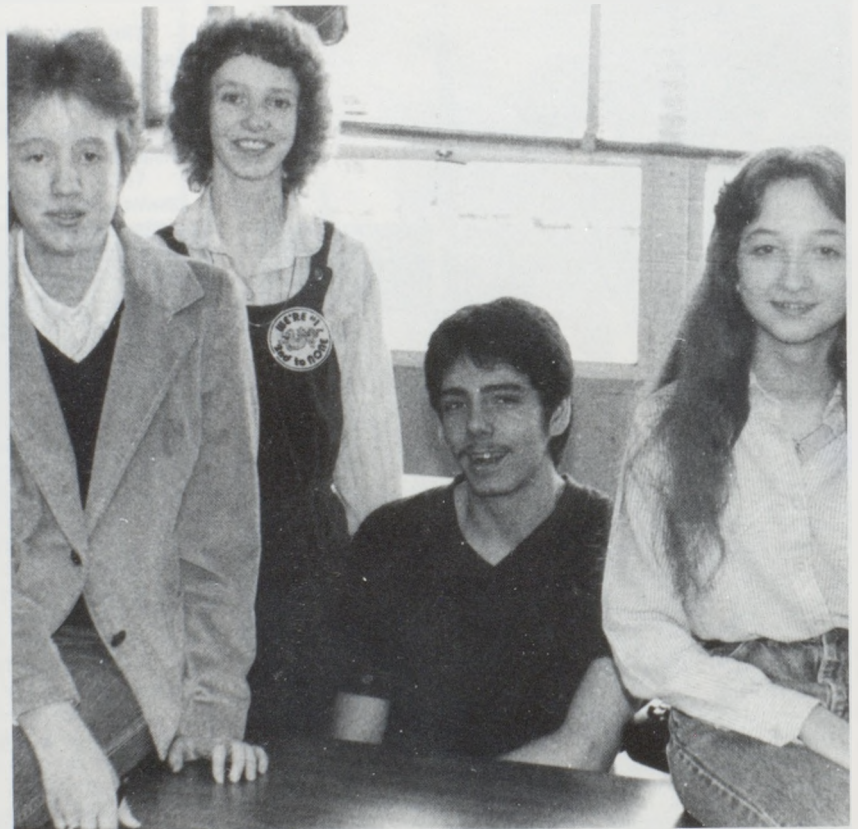
Points accumulated throughout the year were totaled, and those girls who had earned the required amount were allowed to go on a trip to the Food and Drug Administration to close the year.

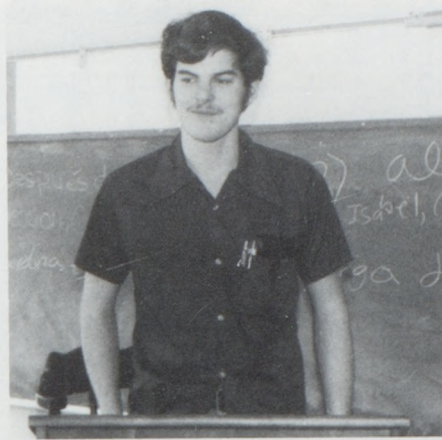

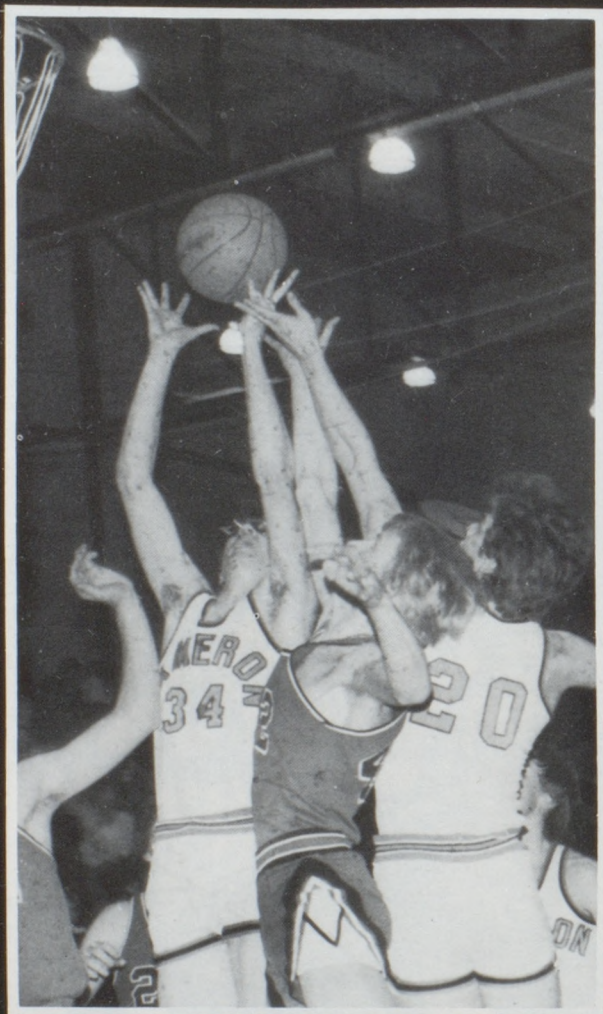
